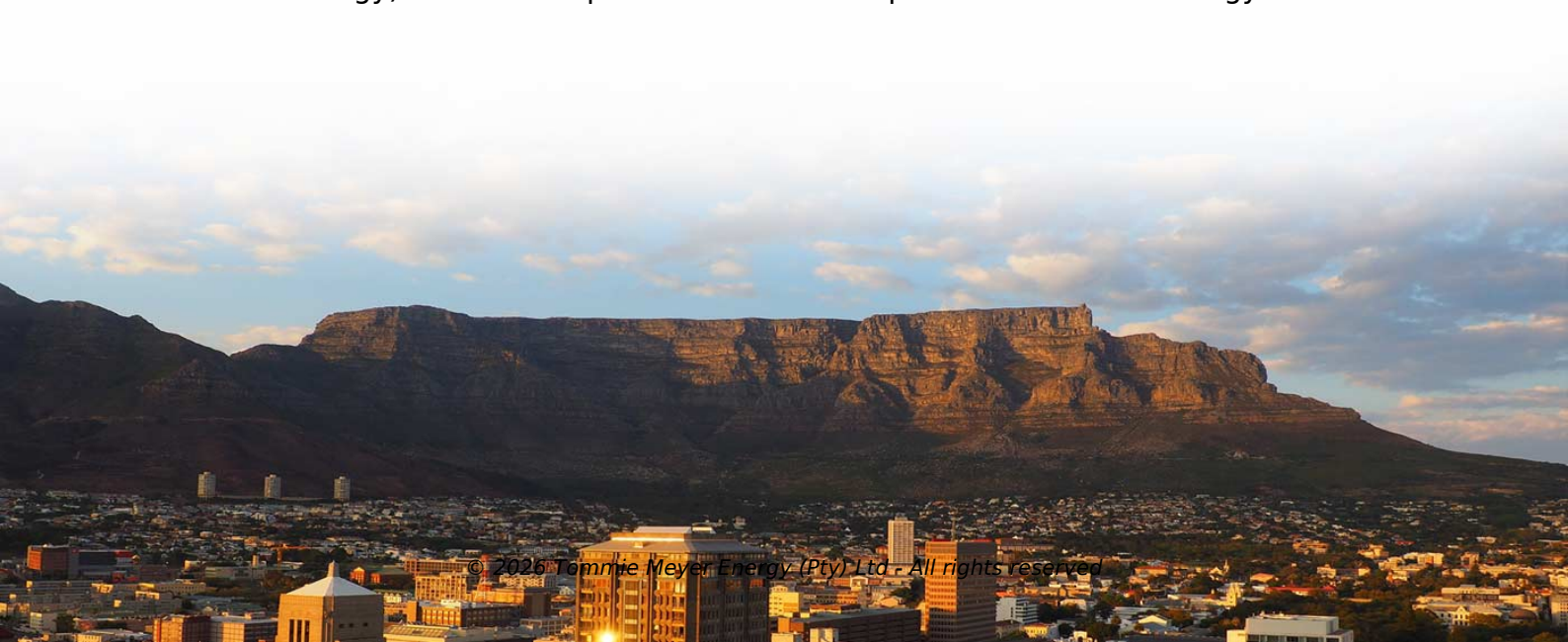


Does the sun affect the power generation of solar panels
