

Is it illegal to rent photovoltaic panels on the roof



Overview

Installing solar panels on a rental property almost always requires your landlord's written permission. The landlord owns the building's structure, including the roof, and most leases explicitly prohibit permanent modifications without approval. Local Law 92 and Local Law 94 require that the roofs of certain buildings be partially covered with green roof or solar photovoltaic electricity generating systems in accordance with the New York City Building Code. At its most basic level, a roof functions to provide protection from the elements. For existing buildings, solar installation work should comply with NYC Construction Codes, NYC Electrical Code, NYC Energy Conservation Code and applicable zoning regulations.
