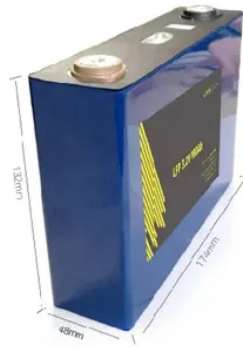


Solar thermal energy juba



Overview

A public-private partnership in South Sudan has launched the country's first major solar power plant and Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) in the capital Juba, where it is expected to provide electricity to thousands of homes. The Juba Solar Power Station is a proposed 20 MW (27,000 hp) solar power plant in South Sudan. The solar farm is under development by a consortium comprising Elsewedy Electric Company of Egypt, Asunim Solar from the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and I-kWh Company, an energy consultancy firm also based. South Sudan has inaugurated its first large-scale solar power project, marking a significant milestone in the country's transition toward renewable energy. Developed and financed by Ezra Construction & Development Group Ltd. Joseph Africano Bartel, Undersecretary of the ministry, calls for increased investment in clean energy to reduce the country's carbon footprint and combat climate.
